

Prologis Park

Prologis Park Hemel Hempstead is a sustainable and energy efficient logistics park with opportunities to secure new Grade A industrial and distribution space in an established logistics location, strategically placed on the M1 corridor to best serve London and the Midlands.



BRE Group Campus

Spencers Park

Hertfordshire has a highly skilled workforce with a strong construction, advanced manufacturing and digital tech skills base.


A stable local workforce, a growing pool of highly skilled and qualified talent, plus graduates from the University of Hertfordshire will help your business thrive.

Hertfordshire IQ is developing a joint action plan with these partners to boost the education offer and local skills development so that employers can rely on the local labour market to help drive productivity.









